EXPECT DELAYS - Lane Closures, Lane Restrictions

Location & Improvements

Village of South Holland – The reconstruction of the 170th Street bridge will be constructed in two stages. The improvements consist of complete superstructure and substructure removal and replacement, pavement reconstruction, pavement patching, pavement resurfacing, curb and gutter replacement, pavement marking, sidewalk construction, lane reconfiguration, curb ramp improvements and all other work as required to complete the improvement.

Traffic Impact

While the project will be able to maintain a lane in each direction at all times, we do anticipate lane closures and restrictions through the duration of the project. Motorists and pedestrians are advised to use caution when traveling in these areas or seek alternate routes.

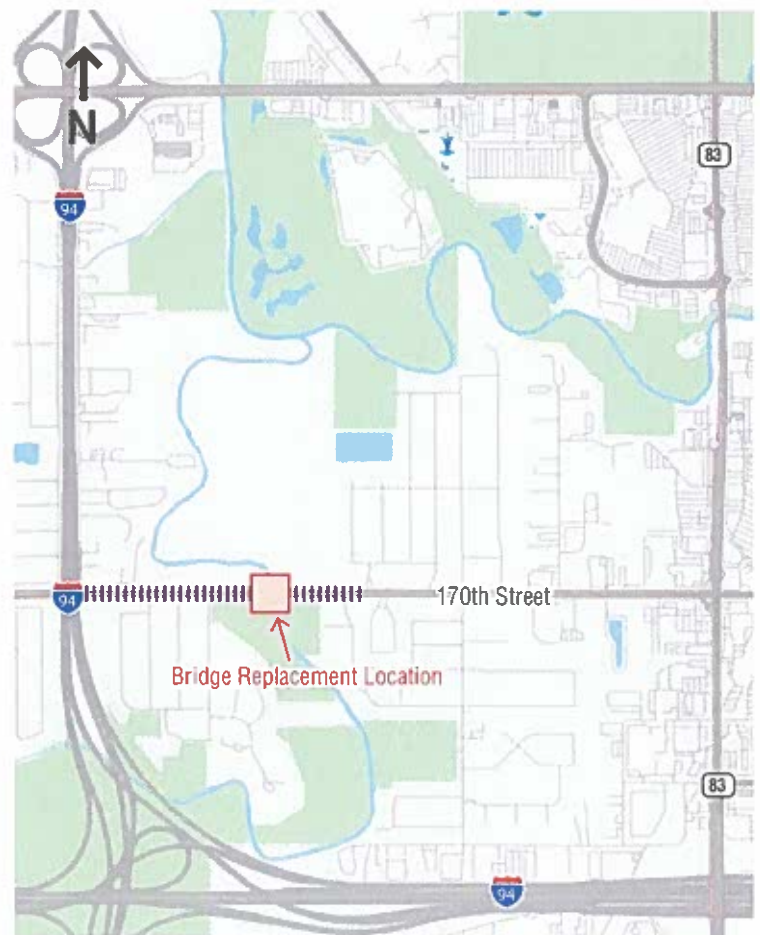
