ARTISTS' GALLERY CRITERIA

- Artists are provided up to two 4' x 8' display boards (see attached photo). Depending on the size of the artwork, this will allow a display of up to **6** pieces (for smaller pieces, the Gallery Committee will allow up to **10** pieces, as long as the display is not overcrowded). Artists **must** display enough art to fill this space.
- Out of respect for South Holland's community standards, the following types of artwork are not allowed: **Nude, Drug- or Gang-related, or Violence.**
- All work that is to be hung on the artboards must be framed and prepared with wire (no sawtooth hangers or sticky tape allowed) to ensure proper hanging. **We will provide eyehooks for hanging.** If canvas artwork does not have a frame, it must be a wrapped canvas, finished and wired.
- When the Gallery is closed, artwork will remain at the Community Center in a secure, locked room. Community Center personnel are present during business hours.
- As the Gallery is an exhibition, sale transactions are prohibited during the show. Artists are encouraged to be available during the Artists' Gallery exhibition to greet and talk with visitors.
- Artists are required to set up their artwork on Thursday, April 9, from 1pm-5pm. All artwork must be displayed before the Friends & Family Reception on Thursday, April 9, at 6pm.
- Artists are required to take/pick up their artwork at the close of the gallery on Friday, April 10, at 8pm. **Early take-down is not permitted.** Please notify the Gallery Committee of any special arrangements.
- The Village of South Holland and the Artists' Gallery Committee are not responsible for artwork that is not picked up on time.
